THE King has been graciously pleased to signify His intention to confer the decoration of the Victoria Cross on the undermentioned Officers and Non-Commissioned Officer whose claims have been submitted for His Majesty's approval, for their conspicuous bravery in South Africa, as stated against their names:—

4th New Zealand Contingent	Farrier-Major W. J. Hardbam	On the 28th January, 1901, near Naauwpoort, this Non-Commissioned Officer was with a section which was extended and botty engaged with a party of about 20 Boers. Just before the force commenced to revire Trooper McCrae was wounded and his horse killed. Farrier-Major Hardham at once went under a heavy fire to his assistance, dismounted and placed him on his own horse, and ran alongside until he had guided him to a place-of safety.
